GRANT PROGRAM

NH Pet Aid accepts applications for grants of up to \$500 from pet owners in financial need residing in Rockingham and Strafford counties. We fund cases for cats and dogs that are urgent in nature and where there is a favorable outlook for the pet's recovery. We do not fund routine care such as annual wellness visits, spaying or neutering, or immunizations.

Our goal is to help pet owners with the greatest financial need, therefore applicants must be on some form of federal, state, or local assistance program. Grants are paid directly to the veterinarian.
